Music:



Beginning Strings: Students want to learn to play violin, viola or cello, no experience needed (Open to grades 6-7-8).

Beginning Band: Students want to play a band instrument: flute, clarinet, oboe, bassoon saxophone, trumpet, trombone. No experience needed. Percussion by audition or teacher recommendation only (Open to grades 6-7-8).

Orchestra: Experienced string players. Students MUST have 1 school year of violin, viola, or cello instruction, or must audition (Open to grades 6-7-8).

Concert Band: 7th and 8th grade wind players who were in band last year,

Keyboard: Students want to learn piano/keyboard, reading music, and creating musical compositions.

Visual Arts:

Art: Students will draw, paint, and sculpt to create two and three dimensional works. Students will learn about art materials, concepts, and vocabulary. Emphasis on originality, creativity, craftsmanship, and effort provides a strong foundation for future art courses. (Open to grades 6-7-8)

Digital Photo: The class broadens and strengthen communication abilities by enhancing visual and graphic Students will earn the basics of photo composition, how to use a DSLR camera, incorporate genres of landscape and macro photography while learning how to edit with PhotoShop.

Performing Arts:

Drama/ Theater Arts: Includes all of the following (Open to grades 6-7-8)

Theater Arts: Students will have the opportunity to explore and develop skills in creative dramatics. Classroom activities include mime/pantomime, improvisation, characterization, technical theater (including: scenery, lighting, sound, costuming, hair/make-up), and play production. Emphasis will be placed on a variety of in-class performances, and individual/group presentations.

Students will have the opportunity to audition for productions. These events will require additional preparation and involvement after school, and on Saturdays.

Video Production: The class presents several video editing techniques including simple editing, chroma key, stop action, voice over, and more. Students also learn the basics of script writing, interviewing and storytelling. Students create individually and in a group to produce videos. The skills learned in this class could inspire students to create YouTube content or pursue a career in video or movie production.
